We will go to great lengths to plan and consider all the subtle nuances of the furniture; how the fabric will behave, where the pattern will align, considerations re: show-wood parts, dimensions etc. and we aim to provide coherent and detailed feedback or commentary to our clients before a project is underway.</p>	<p>Deliberation of patterning and finishing prior to starting a project</p> <p>Via a series of short conversations with the client, we will complete a work-order form for our work-room which takes into consideration the suitability of a chosen fabric, wood-finishes, metal-work, dimensions, fabric width and so on – so that everyone is on the same page from the beginning.</p>
<p>Always available / approachable</p> <p>We have a team of six upholsterers and machinists as well as office staff who are always on-hand to discuss orders / projects. Everyone is briefed on each job whether it is on their bench or elsewhere in the work-room so we will always be able to help answer any questions.</p>	<p>A wealth of knowledge re: frame-making, wood-working and dimensions</p> <p>Our frame-makers work predominantly with kiln-dried beech which is the optimum wood for furniture making. We also work in oak, sapele, walnut and many more FSC approved timbers. The wood-working team will advise as to the structural integrity of a design or the most suitable methods of construction so that our furniture is always solid.</p>	<p>Quality assurance</p> <p>Our furniture undergoes a quality assessment before it leaves the workshop but if there is ever anything that is out of place, we will address it straight away.</p>
